Christmas Craft with recycled items @HQ

As already mentioned in the Pack Note, this craft is going to be made from recycled items only and all crafts will be taken by the leaders to the Fgura Local Council to be hung on the Christmas tree in Reggie Miller square on the occasion of the activity Milied Riciklabbli organized by our Local Council. This activity is to take place on Friday 16th December.

No items are to be bought for this craft since items used can be found in any household. The items needed by the cubs will be listed in a post done on our Facebook Group but most of the items will be made available by the leaders, together with craft items found at our HQ which were never used over time.

Cubs should wear cap & scarf for the meeting and get all the items listed in the post, together with a bottle of water since the meeting is longer than usual in order to make sure that crafts are finished on time. No problem for those cubs who come a bit late because of doctrine lessons if meeting starts 15minutes before since this time will be utilised for explanations.

Fri 9th Dec

Making Cinnamon Balls @HQ

1900-2030H

Today we're going to make some goodies but not for ourselves or to take home with us but to give to the elderly in Dar San Guzepp when we go to visit them the next day!

These cinnamon balls need no baking and when the cubs are ready we pack them up to take them to the elderly on Saturday 10th December when we go to pay them a visit to cheer them up during the festive season. We obviously don't have enough time to do this all in one meeting so for this weekend we decided to meet twice.

Cubs should get the following items:

200g oats; 283g pitted soft dates; 1 tablespoon maple syrup; 1 tablespoon cinnamon; 1/4 teaspoon sea salt; some shredded coconut to roll the balls in.

Note: when it comes to maple syrup, cinnamon and salt, please give the cub the jar of maple syrup and the cinnamon in a closed packet or container (same with the salt) and then we measure out the amounts whilst doing the recipe.

Apart from the ingredients, cubs should get an apron, a tablespoon, a teaspoon, 2 small bowls = 1 to put the mixture in and the other to put the coconut in to roll the balls; a flat plastice plate to put the ready made balls in before packing them up and a wooden spoon.

There will be a blender for each six and the leaders will blend the ingredients together to get the mixture to do the cinnamon balls.

Today we should come with activity hoodie; cap and scarf but with parade trousers please. We meet at HQ and from there we go just down the road to Dar San Guzepp to see some of the retired people there. We will give them the treats which we did for them and if we can, we will sing them the songs we sang for the campfire!

Even though the 4 Link Badge members could not be present yesterday for the Cinnamon ball making since they had an activity with Troop Section, they are still invited to come with the rest of the Pack today to visit the residents of the San Guzepp home (there will be anough cinnamon balls for the link badge to give to the elderly!)

Cubs should come in full activity uniform with cap & scarf and get a face mask with them to be worn when we go to visit the old people. No cub will be allowed without a mask in the home.

Sat 17th Dec

Christmas Activity (+LB) @Bulebel

We will be meeting at Bulebel for the transport to take us to Bugibba where we will be attending a Masterclass in chocolate making at the Malta Chocolate Factory.

Cubs will be taking part in a 1 hour 3D chocolate making class where they will be making a 3D character of their choice, made of chocolate to take home.

Cubs do not need to get anything with them and they should come in activity uniform - with scarf but NO CAP NEEDED.
