

#### A Note from our GSL:

#### Is outdoor scouting back?

- We have a number of awesome ideas for online meetings and activities in mind and we are seeing encouraging levels of engagement from the members.

Nevertheless **we will be making an exception for band members** who will be allowed to meet outdoors for rehearsals as of this month. We felt that it is close to impossible to recreate band rehearsals online and on the other hand it is very easy to maintain social distancing during a band rehearsal. To keep things safe, each band member will be assigned an instrument which they will be using for every rehearsal.

As has been our mantra during this pandemic, "we have to wait and see". If we see that the situation in Malta has remained stable and that the spread of COVID-19 has been sufficiently minimised we will consider organising an outdoor activity or two for each section in August.
