

Dear Parents

The monthly membership fee as from this year will be collected from the cubs every 3 months so fees are due in March, June, September and December of each year. Cubs should get the booklet with them in the first outdoor meeting of the month with the **exact amount** so that we can update the booklet accordingly.

Please note that the monthly fee has been revised due to the fact that it has been like this for years on end and at the moment it is the only source of income for the pack section since we are not organising any outdoor or fund raising activities. On the other hand, we do not wish to cut down or ebolish tokens/gifts to the cubs on particular occasions and we felt that this is a reasonable way forward.

So monthly fee from January 2021 is Eur1 a month instead of Eur0.60.

Fee for March should be paid in the outdoor meeting of Saturday 20th March and for every three months this should now amount to Eur3 instead of Eur1.80.

MOBs should start paying monthly fee with Pack Section from April since up till March they should still pay the Beavers Section.
