

Dear Parents & Cubs

As you can notice, we have started to meet in person in March with the majority of meetings being held outside since the weather will be more favourable.

Pack meetings will be held on Saturday afternoons from 2-4pm. This is the most convenient day and time for the leaders and the majority (if not all) the cubs will not have commitments on Saturday afternoon since most of the extra curricular activities they attend take place on a Saturday morning.

If there are any changes to the meeting, these will be communicated in the Pack Facebook Group so it is up to you to stay up to date please.

The first meeting for this year outside will be dedicated to the reshuffle of sixes - something which we normally used to do in the first meeting of the year in January of each year. The sixes have been the same since COVID broke out since we felt it did not make sense to change the sixes when the cubs were not meeting in person most of the time.

Needless to say it is important that the cubs attend all the meetings as much as possible especially the sessions where we do the scouting progress for the cubs since it will be quite difficult to repeat these sessions only for the cubs who did not attend.

Apart from paying attention to the details of the meetings in the circular, it is very important that the parents keep up to date with the Pack Facebook Group for the latest updates and details.

Cubs should come to each and every meeting with a small backpack with sanitizer, tissues, wipies and enough to drink. Mask should obviously be worn at all times for now.

Kindly note that monthly fees up till March (3 months) are now due. Monthly fee is of Eur1 each month so Eur3 should be paid. Please get monthly fees booklet when paying and give them to Hathi. These fees should be paid in the first meeting of March - Saturday 5th March. (MOBs should NOT pay with Pack for now but they should start paying these monthly fees with cubs when informed by the leaders).

Kindly also note that those parents who wish to pay for 6, 9 or a whole year instead of 3 months, can also do so. Thank you.
