

Please make sure that when a booking is made, the Consent Form is presented with the payment. In order to avoid unnecessary hassle for the leaders to check and collect consent forms which haven't been presented on the booking date, you are kindly requested to come with the Consent Form duly filled in together with payment on the booking date.

The Consent Form can be found in the Downloads Section of our website, and we suggest you print a couple of copies so that you will always have one available when an activity is coming up. The Scout Association of Malta puts a lot of importance on the Consent Form for outdoor activities and we have been informed that we can refuse attendance of a cub if this is not presented - a situation which we would like to avoid.

Fri 3rd May - Sat 4th May Sleepover & DVD Night plus Mother & Cub Activity (+LB) @HQ

1830-1300hrs

No doubt the cubs are thrilled to have a DVD and a sleepover at HQ as was evidenced the last time we had to skip the Zurrieq camp! It is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that cubs do not get a lot of items with them but only what is necessary as follows:

- Mat or foam (to put beneath sleeping bag) PLEASE DO NOT GET HUGE MATTRESSES AS THESE WILL RESTRICT SPACE AVAILABLE
- Sleeping Bag
- Toiletry Bag (plastic or canvas zipped bag) for sleepover this should contain only a small towel (facecloth size), toothbrush and toothpaste and comb or brush.
- Cutlery Bag (drawstring fabric bag) Small flat plate; cereal bowl; cup; cutlery knife, fork, teaspoon, spoon; dishcloth; tissues. All items should be unbreakable and labelled please!!
- Activity Hoodie and T--shirt, jogging pants, cap and scarf These should be brought in a plastic bag for cub to change them in the morning so as not to be soiled the day before since we have the outing. On Friday, cubs can come in a comfortable track suit or jogging pants and sweatshirt which they can easily sleep in (so as not to get another change of clothes). For tonight, we can do without the cap and scarf since these will be used the next day.
- Pocket and Craft Bag which should contain the usual basic items together with UHU stick ad liquid, round edged scissors and any small items to decorate with.
- Small bottle of water
- If there are cubs who need to take medication Friday evening and Saturday morning, parents should get medicine (marked with child's name and dosage) and Health Form. If cub is not taking any medication no health form is needed.

Apart from sleeping bag and mat, all other items should easily fit in a normal sized backpack. Please do not get any other extra items.

On **Saturday 4th May mothers should come at HQ at 9.30am** where transport will take us to Dar Frate Jacoba in Marsascala - a centre belong to the Youth Alive Foundation which gives shelter to the homeless. This institution has its own fields and crops and we are going to render a service by doing a clean-up of the fields, having a talk about the crops grown there, a spiritual thought by Shada, some games and some tea and cake :) where we can relax and get to know each other better.

At the end of the activity we will be collecting a donation for Dar Frate Jacoba as a gesture of thanks for allowing us to do this activity over there.

National Cub Day 2019 - Cub Scout Olympics (+LB) @HQ

Play Like a Champion - this is the theme chosen for this national activity which is going to see the participation of 22 groups and an average of 500 cubs!! The activities are not only sport oriented but more importantly scout oriented and bring out the principles on which scouting is based.....learning with loads of fun and physical, healthy activity!!

Cubs are to attend with activity wear (depending on weather activity t-shirt and maybe get hoodie in backpack), comfortable jogging pants and trainers, cap and scarf. Sunblock should be applied before coming to HQ and please get it with you as well. Cubs should also get a packed lunch and healthy snacks (like fruit) as well as enough to drink for the day. Rain jacket should also be brought - Be Prepared!!

Booking for this activity was done on Friday 22nd March.

Important Note: We have a small walk and cookout on Saturday 25th May but we have no time to collect the transport bookings, so today we will be asking the cubs (at some time during the day) to advise us who is coming or not so as to be able to book transport. Consent Form and payment will be collected on the day, i.e. Saturday 25th May. Please make sure that your son/daughter comes with a proper reply - this will help them to be able to convey a proper message as well.....learning by doing:)

Sat 25th May Small walk and Cookout - Delimara & Bkg for Group Camp @HQ

Before the weather gets too hot, we decided to have a cookout today. The cookout in itself is a session - leaders might decide to conduct other sessions today as well so make sure to get your Cub Book to be prepared!! Please apply sunblock before coming and get it with you just in case another application is needed during the day. Rainjacket is also a must.

Cubs are to come in activity uniform with cap and scarf and should get a backpack with padded straps containing cutlery bag, small cooler bag with items for cookout (burger, sausages, chicken nuggets), maybe a salad and buns or rolls for the burger or hotdog. Please get enough water for the day as well.

- Consent Form + €3 to be given to the leaders today although booking of amount of cubs attending (in order to book transport) was taken on Saturday 11th May 2019.
