

Wed 6th May Scouting Sessions @Virtual 1800-1900hrs

Today we will finally meet again. We will spend some time to discuss how we are spending our time at home. Afterwards, we will refresh our memory on how we should fold our scarf and thus, we will need our scarfs and our woggle.

Wed 20th May Do it yourself - Muffins @Virtual 1800-1900hrs

Today we will meet again to prepare some muffins together with our parents.

For our muffins we will require the following ingredients: 2 eggs, 125ml vegetable oil, 250ml milk, 250g caster sugar, 400g self-raising flour (or same quantity plain flour and 3 tsp baking powder),1 tsp salt, 100g chocolate chips or dried fruit such as sultanas or dried cherries (optional) and any other ingredients you want to add. If during this hour any of the parents are not available, please feel free at do them at any other time, at your convenience.

Wed 27th May Recycled Craft @Virtual 1800-1900hrs

Today we will be going around the house collecting any thing that can be recycled. We will than use our creativity to do a robot theme craft. Group 1 - Blue Six & Green Six & the three girls from White Six (Amy, Alice and Alicia); Time: 10am-11am (sign in 0945am) - Timings might change for certain meetings - please check time for each individual meeting

Group 2 - Red Six & Yellow Six & the three boys from White Six (Matthew, Matteo and Isaac Zahra); Time: 11.30am-12.30pm (sign in 11.15am)

Timings might change for certain meetings - please check time for each individual meeting.

The only exception is the first meeting where we will be meeting all together.

Log in time is given 15 minutes earlier so that meeting can start on time.

Regarding Link Badge members we are co-ordinating with Troop Section to see which meetings they are better off attending with us or with them; especially due to the fact that even Troop meetings are on a Saturday morning. Ian and Gianluca can inform me (Akela) if they wish to attend a pack meeting for which they weren't supposed to attend - as I always tell them they are more than welcome. Needles to say the most important meeting (especially for them) is when it comes to Sessions.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE</u>: After discussions with the GSL and other Section Leaders it transpired that Google Hangouts will not meet the needs of the pack meetings, so for this month we will try using ZOOM and see how it goes. All the details can be found on our Fgura Cub Scouts Facebook Group with instructions how to install (extremely easy) and how to join a ZOOM meeting. A lot of schools are using this platform as well so many of you will already be familiar or have it installed already.

For each and every meeting I will be posting on our Facebook Group a link so that you may connect accordingly. The post will appear on Friday (since meetings will all take place on Saturday morning) so please check the Pack Facebook Group accordingly each and every week.

The rules to be followed during these virtual meetings were already posted on our Facebook Group on the 18th April and I ask all to please follow them closely.

We have also decided to create a Facebook page for the Pack Section - a closed group where only the Pack leaders and the cubs' parents will be the members. This was necessitated since certain feedback can only be given online in these circumstances and even certain updates can be centralized in one point. All parents are now members of this Facebook Group and it is important to keep updated with any news and updates we may be posting.....it doesn't take too long and is important in order to keep up to date and avoid mistakes and mix-ups.

We have also coordinated with the troop Section because of our Link Badge members since even Troop have virtual meetings on a Saturday morning and we have cases of siblings in both Sections; however the parents have kindly confirmed that there will be no problem if certain timings clash since even mobiles can be used for these online meetings and I'm sure these are abundant in all families!!

Proficiency Badges (+MOB) @Virtual

At the moment we are seeing lots of posts where cubs are doing loads of things at home like crafts, etc. This is a good opportunity to do the Pet Care badge for example since you don't have to get your pet to HQ - you can show it to us online; Hobbies badge; Craftsman badge or Collector. Other badges are not practical to do them online; however those cubs who participated in the JOTI in April can do the People & Places badge since point 4 will be covered by this partcipation - they will obviously have to tell us the answers to some questions they asked the other cubs/scouts with whom they had contact. They can then choose to do another 2 points like points 1 and 2 - keep them as simple as possible since we don't have much time although this meeting is a little longer since 1 hour is normally not enough for such a meeting but if we finish before it's no problem.

Cubs are NOT obliged to do a badge and this is purely optional - like when we have a similar meeting at HQ. Cubs are requested to tell us which badge they will be doing today in the previous meeting - on Saturday 9th May so that the leaders will be able to organize the meeting accordingly. If LB members wish to do a badge they can join in any one of the 2 groups - it is purely optional).
