

Troop+Unit - The Olympian Camp @Rinella Scout Campsite

1700-1500hrs

We're super excited about this one - we're going camping again! This will be our first camp since the COVID-19 pandemic began and we just can't wait!

The pandemic still isn't over so we'll be taking some extra measures to ensure a safe camp experience for everyone. Here are some measures which you should know about:

- The camp will be limited to Troop and Unit members only to keep the number of people present low and better ensure social distancing throughout the camp.
- Masks will be worn at all times the only exceptions being for showering, eating and sleeping.
- We will be allocating 4sqm of tent floor space per person (that means 2/3 people sleeping in a 5-person tent).
- Attendees will be sub-divided into groups of 6. They will eat, sleep and participate in activities with members from the same group throughout the camp.
- There will be plenty of hand-sanitizing stations around the campsite.
- We will be checking the attendees' temperature at least twice a day.
- Anyone exhibiting any symptoms will be sent home immediately and asked to report back once s/he is seen by a medical professional.

We are aware that camps pose a significant risk of spreading illnesses and we always take a number of measures to mitigate this risk as much as possible. COVID-19 poses an added challenge for us, but we feel confident that with the added measures we'll be implementing, we can lower the risk to an acceptable level. Members' and parents' cooperation during this camp will be even more important than usual - we know the conditions are not ideal but we're determined to make the most of the situation. Make sure to stay tuned to your section leaders for any further instructions and/or equipment lists.

The Camp Fee will be of €45 for the full camp which covers the cost of the campsite facilities, water and electricity costs, all activities and materials, sanitary supplies, three meals a day, tea breaks and as much drinking water as is required. Camp fee will be collected during the section meetings along with a filled-out consent form.

Members will be asked to bring with them a filled-in <u>Health Form</u> on the first day of the camp and those members who have been vaccinated against COVID-19 will be asked to show their vaccination certificate. Nevertheless unvaccinated members are also welcome to attend the camp.
