



Sat 3rd Sep SEDQA life skills meeting (+LB) @Gnien San Klement

This is the first activity with SEDQA in a series of three spread over September, October and November where various topics like peer preassure and bullying, wise use of technology, commuication skills, etc will be tackled obviously taking into consideration the cubs' age.

Proficiency Badges (+MOB) - Part 1 @Gnien San Klement

Sat 1st Oct

This will be the first of two proficiency badges meetings to give the opportunity to cubs to do a badge of their liking and present it in front of their fellow cubs. The second meeting will be a week later (Saturday, 8th October). If weather does not permit, the meetings will be held at our HQ,

It is important to note that cubs are free to choose whether they do a badge or not however we highly encourage them to do so.

We suggest that the younger cubs (bronze arrow cubs or MOBs) choose a badge which is easy to present like Pet Care, Hobbies, Collector, Artist, Craftsman; however if they feel they are able to do another badge they can go ahead and do so and if in difficulty ask Akela or any other leader of the Pack.

It is important that the leaders are informed which badge the cub will be doing not later than the 12th of September since on that day pack leaders will be having a section meeting and we will group the cubs according to the badge they chose, so that if more than one cub chooses the same badge it makes more sense to group them together to see them and manage time wisely. That way the cubs will also know when they are to present their badge - either on Saturday 1st of October or the week after. They will obvio9usly be informed accordingly by the leaders.

We do not wish the cubs to use power point presentations for these sessions but if they want a form of presentation they can do a traditional chart which can be more simple but represents more their own work and not a copy and paste.

In the weekend of Friday 9th or Saturday 10th September we will be doing a reminder post on the Cubs' Facebook Group regarding these proficieny badges, so that the parents can post which badge their son/daughter will be doing. Parents of MOBs will be given all the details when we have the parents' meeting (to be informed by Keo) since this will be their first time doing a badge with the Pack.
