



Anniversary Camp Rinella Campsite Pack Camp List



Activity Uniform

Blue activity sweat shirt, jogging pants, scarf, activity cap, comfortable slippers/walking shoes (depending on the weather it is advisable not to get jeans as these will not keep you warm)

Other Clothing

2 tracksuits or separate jogging pants & sweatshirts
Comfortable tracksuit (or any other clothing) to sleep in
5 pairs of socks
Underwear
Rain jacket
Warm waterproof jacket (with hood)
Parade uniform (shirt & trousers) in a separate plastic bag – no need for black shoes

Bedding

Foam OR Inflatable Mattress – not too wide please
Sleeping bag & warm blanket
Pillow (optional)
No camp beds will be used in this camp for both boys and girls – boys will be sleeping in dormitories and girls in hike/dome tents

Toiletries

Small Towel & Facecloth
Shower Gel
Toothbrush & Toothpaste
Comb or Brush
Mosquito Repellant (CREAM ONLY)
Flip-flop or similar for showering
Antiseptic wet wipes/Tissues
Plastic bag for dirty clothes

**SHOWER
BAG (waterproof soft case)**

Meals

Fork, Knife, Spoon (**Durable plastic not disposable**)
Plastic Mug/Cup
2 Plastic Plates (1 Deep and 1 Flat)
Dish Cloth & Tissues/Paper Napkins
Empty Bottle – to fill with water when necessary

BAG (fabric)**

Misc Items

Torch
Note Book
Craft Bag (pencils, pens, ruler, eraser, colouring pencils/markers/crayons, scissors – not pointed, UHU liquid glue and UHU stick)
Money for TUC Shop – not more than € 5

- **VERY IMPORTANT: All ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH CHILD'S NAME – EVEN UNDERWEAR**
- We suggest you either separate clothes items in different plastic bags, for example trousers, tops, underwear, socks, etc; or else put a set of clothes to make up an outfit in separate bags; for example a pair of trousers, top, socks, underwear in a single bag. Depends what suits you most.
- Gold arrow and link badge cubs are to arrive at campsite at 5.00pm on Friday 24th November to help with pitching of tents.
- The rest of the cubs (except one nighters) are to arrive at campsite on Friday 24th November, at 6.00pm.
- Cubs will have dinner at camp on Friday evening, so there is no need for a packed lunch.
- One nighters should arrive at campsite on Saturday 25th November at 7.30am for flag break and breakfast.
- Camp ends for one nighters on Sunday 26th November at 4pm with the rest of the cubs.
- Shower bags should preferably be a waterproof soft case; whilst the cutlery bag should be made of fabric.
- Craft bag is very important for this camp since it will be used for the group activity....so make sure that all items listed are in it!
- Since this is our 30th anniversary camp, we are going to use the parade uniform for Mass. There will also be some presentations. There is no need to get the black parade shoes. The same slippers/walking shoes can be worn.
- Cubs can come to the camp with the group activity sweatshirt, cap and scarf since parade uniform will be worn for Mass and so the sweatshirt doesn't have to be kept clean for this occasion.
- Please do not forget health form to be handed in to leaders (together with any medicines – if there is need) on arrival at campsite.
- Cutlery bag should also be left in hall upon arrival at camp.
- Strictly no mobiles or electronic games are allowed – for no reason. Cubs can only opt to get a small board game with them.
- Please **DO NOT GIVE SWEETS** or any other extra snacks to cubs. There will be enough food at the camp and if they wish to have a small snack (after meals) they can use the TUC Shop – please do not give more than € 5.
- Parents are to pick all cubs at 4pm on Sunday and preferably be present for closing ceremony at that time.
