We obviously suggest that these food items are brought in a small cooler case and dads should also get their personal tongs, palettes and skewers together with their cutlery items. Cubs should get their cutlery bag. We suggest you get some toilet paper with you since use of toilets will be made available at the Ghajn Tuffieha Campsite. For those who so wish, a large towel/mat can be brought with you to relax and sit on whilst eating....although Scouts do not normally mind sitting down on the ground or on the grass!! The Ghajn Tuffieha Campsite have also made available one of the barracks for us as a refuge from the sun and to relax/eat in.
